







Cooking Experience

<Udon/Soba Making Experience>

"Udon" is made from flour while soba is made from buckwheat flour. Udon is often eaten for lunch and on special occasions, especially in the Kagawa prefecture. The prefecture also features many udon shops across the area. When making Udon, the dough is kneaded, stepped on, rested, stretched, cut, and boiled (soba is made in a similar way). The taste of freshly made udon is exquisite!

<Okudo-san Experience>

Until about 60 years ago and before the spread of electric rice cookers, Japanese people used to cook rice using a stove with fire made from small chunks of wood. Learn to cook delicious rice using traditional methods, and make rice balls.
