## Class 1

### *Celtic Languages: The History and Survival of Ireland's Native Language*

This talk introduces the Celtic languages of Ireland, Scotland, and Wales, with a particular focus on the Irish language (Gaeilge). Participants will learn about the history of Celtic languages, how they survived despite centuries of political and social change, and their role in modern Irish identity and culture. The session will also explore Irish place names, pronunciation, music, and everyday expressions, giving participants a chance to experience one of Europe's oldest living language traditions.
